Along with Polish partners (LLC "FUTURE PROCESSING UKRAINA") the college participates in implementation of the long-term program of technological development of the city within the SMART CITY project.

With the support of Polish-German Cooperation of Youth the Ukrainian-Polish-German project "Through the stomach to a common Europe without borders" was implemented in 2018. The first session of the project was held in Ternopil on May 29 - June 03, 2018. The second was held in the town of Zbongshin (Poland) in September 24-28, 2018.

In the period from March 6 to 11, 2019, the joint project "Woman is changeable" was successfully realized, and in September 2020, the Ukrainian-Polish-German youth distant project "Cooking on the screen" was implemented.

In March 2019 Halytskyi College participated in a project initiated by the Institute of Political Sciences of the University of Warsaw as an international (Ukraine-Poland-Netherlands-Sweden-Belarus) research on youth participation in public life using the Photo Voice method.

Within the program of international cooperation Erasmus+ - international projects "Image in the Global World" (Nowy Sącz, Poland, June 25- July 4, 2019) and "Youth Entrepreneurship" (Kety, Poland, November 3-10, 2021).

The international Ukrainian-Polish project "What it means to be a citizen", supported by the Polish-Ukrainian Youth Exchange Council, took place in Plonsk (Poland) in September 2019 and aimed to strengthen intercultural dialogue between young people, mutual knowledge of history and modernity, formation of democracy, understanding young people's role in the formation of civil society and its values, awareness of their rights and the need to exercise them for the successful development of their land and country.

In February 2021 was signed the cooperation Agreement between the Halytskyi College named after Vyacheslav Chornovil and the University of Applied Sciences in Nysa, motivated by a mutual desire to cooperate in the field of higher education and scientific research and the conviction that this cooperation is in the interest of both Parties, as well as the desire to improve and develop it.
